## Mavro Helps Boys Town Create a Versatile “Imaging Center” for Processing Donations, Forms, and Documents

### *A Ten Year Old System Needed Replacement*

Headquartered in Nebraska, Boys Town is a nonprofit organization dedicated to changing the way America cares for children, families, and communities by providing and promoting an integrated continuum of care that instills Boys Town values to strengthen body, mind, and spirit.

The Boys Town lockbox processes approximately 1.5 million donor contributions (cash, check, credit card) received by mail each year. Their existing system was 10 years old with a single point of failure and was limited to processing simple check and stub donations.

Boys Town wanted to implement an image-based system that could process a wide range of payment types and document sizes, support PCI compliance, and include Image Cash Letter (ICL) electronic deposit. They also wanted to integrate with their donor database, their data warehouse, and several different accounting systems. An additional primary goal was to eliminate the need for operators to examine paper donation documents and manually separate them based on donation type and correspondence type.

### *An Image-Based Workflow Streamlines Donations Handling*

After a detailed operational review and working closely with the Boys Town team, Mavro implemented a system that incorporates Boys Town’s existing Opex Model 50 and Model 51 mail extractors, a new Opex Model AS7200i scanner, and an IBML ImageTrac-Lite scanner, along with Mavro’s industry-leading MavBridge™ Software, specifically designed for nonprofits.

The Model 50/51 extractors and the ImageTrac scanner now handle opening and scanning large volumes of uniform size donation documents. Meanwhile, the versatility of the AS7200i allows it to open and scan a variety of donations and documents in a wide range of sizes. And if either the ImageTrac or the AS7200i is disabled, the alternate operational scanner can be used to process the donations, eliminating the previous single point of failure.

With MavBridge™, operators no longer need to read the physical donation documents, perform any kind of manual sorting, or move paper between departments. Once the documents are opened and scanned, the Mavro system extracts critical information, recognizes different donation types, performs lookup validation, and routes donations to the proper processing stream. Images of donations with supplementary content, such as those with correspondence, are presented to operators for review. In turn, operators can classify the documents and route them to an image-based workflow for proper

processing. MavBridge™ automatically outputs document images and donations data to a custom-designed interface for Boys Town’s Blackbaud CRM system. The Mavro System also outputs financial data to multiple legacy accounting systems and summary information to a data warehouse.

Furthermore, the redaction capabilities built into MavBridge™ Software help ensure that Boys Town can meet PCI requirements. And because the Mavro solution includes ICL electronic deposit capability, the need for check encoding and manual deposit is eliminated.

### ***Lockbox and Receipt Operations Has Become an “Imaging Center”***

The inherent versatility of MavBridge™ allowed the Mavro System to be extended well beyond processing donations.
